This morning I sat down for a group time with the children to read the book '5 little men in a flying saucer' as I began to sing the children all crawled over to join in, examining the pages of the book and listening as I read/sang. Taejarn and Melia pointed out the different pictures in the book that they found interesting, the alien/men being the most interesting! Henry and Connor took turns to help turn the pages, enjoying being helpful! Once we finished reading the book I turned on the speaker and put the 5 little men song on, the children danced along, attempting to repeat the actions after me. Books at this age help children learn sounds, words and language and also develop their literacy skills!

Today for art the children created their own flying saucers! Using paper plates the children painted their flying saucer using paintbrushes and different coloured paint to choose from. As Henry dabbed his paintbrush he made excited sounds “ohh!” when he noticed the paint transferring onto the paper. Melia giggled excitedly as she painted, fascinated by the colours. Connor was very interested in the paint, using the paintbrush to paint his hand and the plate!
